WEX12A and WEX12B



Elective Work Experience courses (WEX12A and WEX12B) are available to students in grades 9-12. Students interested in taking this course are required to complete an application package. WEX12 courses are "out of the timetable", which means that students must be able to make time to complete the course requirements, often outside of school hours.

WEX12A and WEX12B each require students to complete 100 hours and students must complete all paperwork and applications prior to starting to count hours. Students that complete a WEX12 course will receive 4 credits toward graduation.

Students that want to earn the 4 WEX12B credits must again complete all application requirements **and** be able to demonstrate NEW skills and learning from their WEX12A course. Come to the Career Centre for more information!!
