

School Fees 2025

Listed below are the permissible school fees in compliance with provincial legislation. A **financial hardship policy** is in place at PVSS for families unable to afford school fees. Please contact school administration for further information.

Permissible Fees-due by September 30th: \$37

Student Activity Fee: \$20
Cultural Performances: \$12
Yearly Lock Fee \$5

Requested Fees:

- PE Strip (if student would like to purchase)
 - o available at the office for \$38 t-shirt and shorts (t-shirt \$15, shorts \$23)
- Athletic team fees
 - required if your child chooses to participate to cover bussing, entry fees, uniforms, scorekeeper and referee fees, and other travel costs
 - o coaches will send home information about costs
 - students must pay their fees before playing in games
- Band instruments
 - o rentals are available privately or through the school district
 - o please contact the band teacher for more information
- Field trips
 - o information will be sent home with field trip permission forms
 - fees are often requested to cover bussing, entry fees, food, activities
- Graduation fee (\$200)
 - for those graduates choosing to participate in commencement and graduation activities
 - all school-related graduation activities (including cap and gown, arena rental, commencement ceremony, photos, yearbooks, etc.) – \$150
 - all parent-committee activities (including prom and dry grad celebration) \$50 (the grad parent committee may request additional fundraising support throughout the year)

Paying Fees:

We have an e-transfer payment option. All fees can be paid through e-transfer to pvs@sd83.bc.ca. Please ensure that you include your student's first and last name in the message and list the fees being paid.

Parents can also log in to Parent Connect and look under the "FEES" tab. Select the "FEES FOR PAYMENT" option. Parents can then select the fees they wish to pay at this time, and click on the button that says "READY TO PAY". Using this option allows fees to be paid using credit cards.



Fees can still be paid directly in the office with cash or a cheque; however, we are recommending that one of the above options be utilized if possible.
