#### **Spectator Code of Conduct**

Aggressive, threatening or other inappropriate behaviour by team members, their families, and others while attending a game or event will not be tolerated. Spectators are expected to follow the BC School Sports Spectator Code of Conduct. Focusing on having a supportive and encouraging environment can help maintain a positive atmosphere for both athletes and other spectators.

#### Behaviours that are not tolerated include but are not limited to:

- Using offensive language
- Taunting, harassing or ridiculing players, coaches, officials or other spectators
- Targeting others by making racist, religious, sexist, homophobic or other inappropriate comments to players, coaches, officials or other spectators
- Putting undue and unwanted pressure on athletes, berating or targeting them by putting down their performance

#### What our Athletic Department will do:

- Provide teams, their family and others with the Spectator Code of Conduct and make clear what is expected and the consequences for non-compliance
- Reinforce messages of fair and respectful behaviour by displaying signs and posters around our facilities and providing information
- Encourage our coaches to be familiar with the Spectator Code of Conduct
- Encourage the reporting of incidents and investigate inappropriate behaviours as outlined in this policy and take disciplinary or whatever other actions are deemed necessary
- Set a standard on the sideline that offensive and abusive language is not tolerated by anyone, nor directed at anyone.

Failing to follow our code of conduct can result in removal from the event or facility.

Together we aspire to provide a safe learning environment which fosters the development of self-esteem, social responsibility, intellectual growth and lifelong learning.
